Central government support

- DEFRA is making up to £2 million available for farming businesses affected.
- It is expected the fund will be modelled on the Farming Recovery Fund set up after the Cumbria floods.
- Farms will be able to apply for grants to cover uninsured costs of getting their farms back in production.

The Prince's Countryside Fund

- £50,000 will be made available from its emergency fund to assist farmers and rural communities affected by the flooding in Reeth and Arkengarthdale.
